## TOYOTA LANDCRUISER CLUB (QLD.) INC. ("Club").

### BY-LAWS

#### 1.0 REGULATIONS

All members and visitors shall at all times abide by these By-laws, other Club rules, regulations laid down by all government authorities and the requirements of owners of private property.

#### 2.0 CLUB IDENTIFICATION

Any member who at any time can be identified with the Club either visibly or in any way whatsoever shall be bound to comply with these By-laws for the full duration of the time in which such identification may be possible. All Club identification must be removed from vehicles prior to disposal.

#### 3.0 DISCIPLINE

All members and visitors participating in Club activities, events and trips ("activities") shall at all times abide by the directions and instructions of the appointed activity leader and/or their representative for the activity, in respect of:

- (a) safety of other members
- (b) fire precautions
- (c) care and respect of or for private property
- (d) any other matter consistent with the Club's rules, by-laws, interests and philosophy as the activity leader may see fit.

#### 4.0 DUTY OF CARE

All persons participating in activities must acknowledge that the activities thereon can be inherently dangerous and that they undertake the activities of their own free will, accepting full responsibility for their own actions at all times whilst engaged on the activity.

All persons participating in activities must agree to indemnify and keep indemnified the Club, its authorized officers, the leader and his/her assistants from all claims and litigation howsoever arising. Guardians should sign for under 18 year old participants.

Care should be taken by everyone to ensure that workplace health and safety measures are put in place to ensure safety for everyone. Use suitable personal protective equipment and clothing when necessary.

Vehicles are not to be left unattended with their engines running.

Monitor alcohol and drug use particularly when using motor vehicle or camp equipment.

Abide by the rules and regulations of the various government agencies that govern our Club's operations and activities, and obtain all necessary permissions and permits.

#### 5.0 FIREARMS

Firearms must not be carried in vehicles or by Club members during the course of any Club activity unless the activity is of that nature and approved by the Management Committee.

#### 6.0 GENERATORS

Restrictions apply in many parks and also at the discretion of land managers. The leader of the activity has the final say as to their use.

## **7.0 LAND MANAGERS**

Follow all instructions laws and acts imposed by land managers.

Obtain permission to enter their land.

Seek permission before driving on private land. Do not disturb livestock or watering points, and leave gates as found.

## **8.0 MUSIC**

Loud music is not permitted unless the activity is of that nature.

## **9.0 DOMESTIC PETS**

The leader of the activity to obtain advice from the land manager and then final say rests with the activity leader unless otherwise advised by the Management Committee.

Where permitted, pet owners are responsible for the management of their pets.

## **10.0 OFF ROAD DRIVING**

Obey the laws and regulations for recreational vehicles that apply to public lands and any signs etc. displayed by land managers.

## **11.0 ON ROAD DRIVING**

Obey all the laws and regulations that apply to vehicles on public and private roads.

## **12.0 PAYMENT OF FEES**

**12.1** Persons accepted to membership of the Club from and after 1 October to and including 30 April in any year shall pay a pro-rata fee as listed on the Club's website. Persons accepted to membership from and including 1 May in any year shall pay a full subscription which shall entitle them to membership to and including 30 June in the following year.

**12.2** The Management Committee may at its discretion apply special promotional membership fees for special events eg. 4X4 Show.

**12.3** A membership application and appropriate fees are to be submitted via the Club's website or submitted directly to the Club.

## **13.0 PROPERTY**

Club property shall be under the control of the Property Officer appointed by the Management Committee. Club property shall be used only on official Club activities or otherwise by arrangement with the Management Committee.

## **14.0 VISITORS**

Members shall be responsible at all times for the behaviour of their visitors when engaged in any Club activity. Visitors are not permitted to drive on any 4WD activity.
