Appendix A. BY-LAWS

TOYOTA LANDCRUISER CLUB (QLD) Inc.

BY-LAWS

1.0 REGULATIONS

All members and visitors shall at all times abide by these by-laws, other club rules and regulations laid down by all government authorities and the requirements of owners of private property.

2.0 CLUB IDENTIFICATION

Any member who at any time can be identified with the club either visibly or in any way whatsoever shall be bound to comply with these by-laws for the full duration of the time in which such identification may be possible. All club identification must be removed from vehicles prior to disposal.

3.0 DISCIPLINE

All members and visitors participating in club activities shall at all times abide by the directions and instructions of the appointed activity leader and/or their representative for the activity in respect of:

- (a) safety of other members
- (b) fire precautions
- (c) care and respect of or for private property
- (d) any other matter consistent with the club's rules, by-laws, interests and philosophy as the activity leader may see fit.

4.0 DUTY OF CARE

Care should be taken by everyone to ensure that workplace health and safety measures are put in place to ensure safety for everyone.

Use of suitable clothing and footwear when necessary.

Monitor alcohol use particularly when using motor vehicle or camp equipment.

Abide by the rules and regulations of the various government agencies that govern our clubs operations and activities

5.0 FIREARMS

Firearms must not be carried in vehicles or by club members during the course of any club activity.

6.0 GENERATORS

Restrictions apply in many parks and also at the discretion of land managers. The activity leader has the final say as to there use.

7.0 LAND MANAGERS

Follow all instructions laws and acts imposed by land managers.

Obtain permission to enter their land.

Seek permission before driving on private land. Do not disturb livestock or watering points, leave gates as found.

8.0 MUSIC

Loud music is not permitted unless the function is of that nature.

9.0 DOMESTIC PETS

Not encouraged, but activity leader to obtain advice from the land manager and then final say rests with the activity leader unless otherwise advised by the executive.

10.0 OFF ROAD DRIVING

Obey the laws and regulations for Recreational Vehicles that apply to public lands and any signs etc. displayed by land managers.

11.0 ON ROAD DRIVING

Obey all the laws and regulations that apply to vehicles on public and private roads.

12.0 PAYMENT OF FEES

12.1 Persons accepted to membership of the club from and after 1 January to and including 30 April in any year shall pay a joining fee and half annual subscription. Persons accepted to membership from and including 1 May in any year shall pay a full subscription which shall entitle them to membership to and including 30 June in the following year.

Fees must be submitted in conjunction with an application and received by the Treasurer at a general meeting no later than three months after completion of orientation.

12.2 If a member wishes to rejoin before a 3 year period has lapsed.

1. Can back pay fees for the lapsed time
2. No New Member's Day required
3. Membership number reinstated
4. No back issues of club magazine will be issued

12.3 If a member wishes to rejoin after a 3 year period has lapsed.

1. Pay yearly membership fee
2. New Member's Day required
3. New membership number issued

13.0 PROPERTY

Club property shall be under the control of the Property Officers appointed by the Management Committee. Club property shall be used only on official club activities or otherwise by arrangement with the Management Committee.

14.0 VISITORS

Members shall be responsible at all times for the behaviour of their visitors when engaged in any club activity. Visitors are not permitted to drive on any 4WD activity.
